1. The magnificent superyacht SUERTE is a joint project of the bespoke Tankoa Yachts with Vincenzo Ruggiero (naval architecture) and Francesco Paszkowski (design). Her amazing interior design is another features that makes her stand out from the line of charter yachts. Interior layout consists of 5 guests cabins, including a 180 degree master suite. Family friendly charter yacht offers accommodation in 6 stunning ensuite cabins with the following configuration: a spacious master suite, 3 double and 2 twin cabins. Cruising around the Caribbean Islands will be more entertaining on this vessel, as there is a large selection of water toys available: water skies, paddle boards, wave runners, underwater cameras and fishing equipment.

3. If you are looking for even more space for specialising and relaxation, then COCOA BEAN by Trinity Yachts can be a perfect option. Her exterior spaces are exceptional with living spaces offered on 5 decks. The observation lounge with seating, cocktail tables, sunpads, Jacuzzi and wet bar are located on the upper deck for a great get-together. If you opt for some intimate and quiet atmosphere, the sundeck would be your favourite place on board, as it features more sunpads, seating and opens picturesque views.

4. So yachts that go through the ice? Yachts that have helicopters? Submarines? What about all three? The fully classified Class 1 ice-breaking ship, LEGEND recently underwent a facelift and can now carry 26 guests in luxury rather than the previous 12, to both Antarctica and the Arctic. The Legend now charts a new course with many adventures along the way while guests are served first class cuisine and enjoy the 13 staterooms, including a Master suite, two VIP suites, four double staterooms and six convertible staterooms. She is also capable of carrying up to 19 crew on board, plus a 10 expedition crew that includes an ice-pilot, expedition leaders and a doctor. Top thrills within the ultimate luxury included.
