Tankoa Calls Mega-Yacht Vertige Sea Trials a Success

The 164-foot mega-yacht Vertige exceeded her contract-specified speeds during sea trials.

The Tankoa shipyard in Italy has completed sea trials on its first mega-yacht in the S501 series, the 164-foot Vertige. Per the contract with the owner, the yacht was supposed to achieve 16 knots. During the sea trials, she topped out at 16.5 knots with a 60-percent load.

“There were no vibrations at all, and the decibel readings were inferior to contracted levels,” Edoardo Ratto, Tankoa’s general manager, stated in a press release. “In the owner’s suite and VIP cabin, levels were below 50 decibels.”

Exterior design on *Vertige* is by Francesco Paszkowski, with interiors by Paszkowski and Margherita Caprini.

Delivery to the owners is scheduled this month.

How long did the build take? Tankoa inked the deal to construct *Vertige* in February 2015.
