The Tankoa Suerte S693 breaks charter records! Despite being booked for the Monaco Yacht Show, the Tankoa Suerte S693 was also hired for the entire season, with a record breaking 20 weeks consecutive charter. The first Tankoa S501 is set to be delivered to its buyer, an experienced French client. Construction of the S501 started early May 2015 and is set for completion and delivery in April 2017. More news from the Tankoa camp is the announcement of a new 62m superyacht concept called the Tankoa S621. Yacht designer Francesco Paszkowski has created harmonious volumes characterized by the extended aft, with an oversized beach club, an elegant lounge and a infinity pool. The Tankoa S621 incorporates all the qualities that distinguish the level of excellence Tankoa Yachts is known for. Francesco Paszkowski commented: "The new



Tankoa S621 is inspired by the first two yachts of the shipyard – the 69m Suerte and the project S501- laying the foundation of the contemporary era of Tankoa Yachts. To the first inspirations, the new 62m adds and develops new distinctive features in order to create a yacht where the shipyard's signature is immediately recognizable. While the lines of the aft and those of the bow remind Tankoa S501 and the shape of the superstructure recalls Suerte, in the project of the 62m, the windows become larger to enhance light of the interiors while the superstructure becomes even more rigorous".
