Why is she so special? This 85-metre catamaran won't leave guests short of space – across the hulls there's a massive 25-metre beam, and an aft deck that can be configured just how you want it. Here, there's a huge pool with sunloungers, while on the sundeck

there's a cinema area. Propulsion options go from a conventional system for 20-knot performance to a hybrid Codag system delivering over 40. The semi-Swath catamaran hull form means Project L³ will be a stable cruising platform in all weathers.
