## Heesen

Heesen has presented its largest vessel yet: Kometa, a 70-meter superyacht that has everything you can imagine and more. To create its sleek, elegant profile Espen Odiño was in charge. He worked closely with Sinot Exclusive Yacht Design to accomplish an elegant, classic contemporary design for the interior. Externally, this magnificent yacht, thanks to its superabundance of space, has it all: from 357 square-meters of deck space to a seven-meter swimming pool, Jacuzzis, spa space, dining and even an outdoor cinema. There is no excuse to not have a good time! Besides, it has accommodations for twelve guests, in six suites. To the master stateroom, Heesen has left no detail unattended. Spaciousness is what really characterizes this soon-to-be vessel.

Despite its tremendous size, Kometa is a fusion of three different concepts that let it reach a maximum 30 knots speed, but also to cruise economically for over 4.000 nautical miles. This means that the technologies of both displacement and semi-displacement hulls will be at use. Therefore, the engineering system will be outstanding, including the revolutionary Fast Displacement Hull Form, a groundbreaking fixed pitch propeller without precedents and a Rolls Royce central booster jet, among others.

Heesen Yachts paid attention to every detail, producing an extraordinarily complete superyacht. Kometa has already past the initial stages of construction and it is estimated to be delivered in spring 2016.

## M/V Yersin

François Fiat, Ambassador of La Belle Classe Superyachts, a label created by the Yacht Club de Monaco in 2005 to support owners in their navigation, presented its new project: the M/V Yersin. It's an extraordinary vessel named after the Doctor Alexander Yersin.

M/V Yersin is being built by the Piriou Shipyard in France. This 77-meter vessel, with a capacity for 20 passengers and 20 crew, is intended to navigate in any conditions, including ice exploration. What is so distinctive and impressive of this soon-to-be investigation vessel is its advanced, eco-friendly technology, which goes in hand with the values preached by La Belle Classe. Among other innovative features of the technology employed, we can affirm that this one-of-a-kind ship has an autonomy of 12.000 nautical miles and avoids any exterior or interior pollutant releases. Besides, she will be able to accommodate an airplane on board.

M/V Yersin has a fundamental role in spreading and entrenching this new green vision about the world and promoting the environment protection. This ship is aimed to achieve an A.S.E project: Adventure – Science – Education, three fundamental pillars to inquire and improve globally; and more specifically essential for La Belle Classe and the nautical world.

The M/V Yersin truly meets the expectations stated in its logo "Leave an imprint without leaving a trace."
