AZIMUT YACHTS BEGINS SHOW SEASON IN STYLE

Two world premieres and a total of fifteen yachts head to Cannes.

Azimut Yachts will be starting the season with two hotly-anticipated world premieres: the Magellano 66 and the Azimut 72. The Magellano 66, at 20-meters, will offer her owner the freedom of long-range cruises surrounded by the elegance and comforts of a luxury apartment. The 66 is the fifth model of the Magellano Collection, and shares its Dual Mode hull with the previous models, ensuring comfortable sailing whatever the sea conditions. Spacious interiors and a spectacular terrace on the flybridge are her most striking features and we expect her to be very popular on with the more adventurous boat owner. Joining the Magellano 66 is the completely new Azimut 72. This cutting-edge craft has been designed from the offset to make use of modern composites, with carbon fibre playing a big part in her construction.
