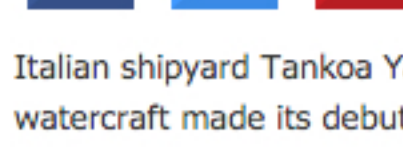




Italian-Made Suerte Superyacht



Italian shipyard Tankoa Yachts has unveiled its new Suerte superyacht. At 227.4-feet, the super sleek, steel and aluminum watercraft, made its debut at the 2015 Monaco Yacht Show.

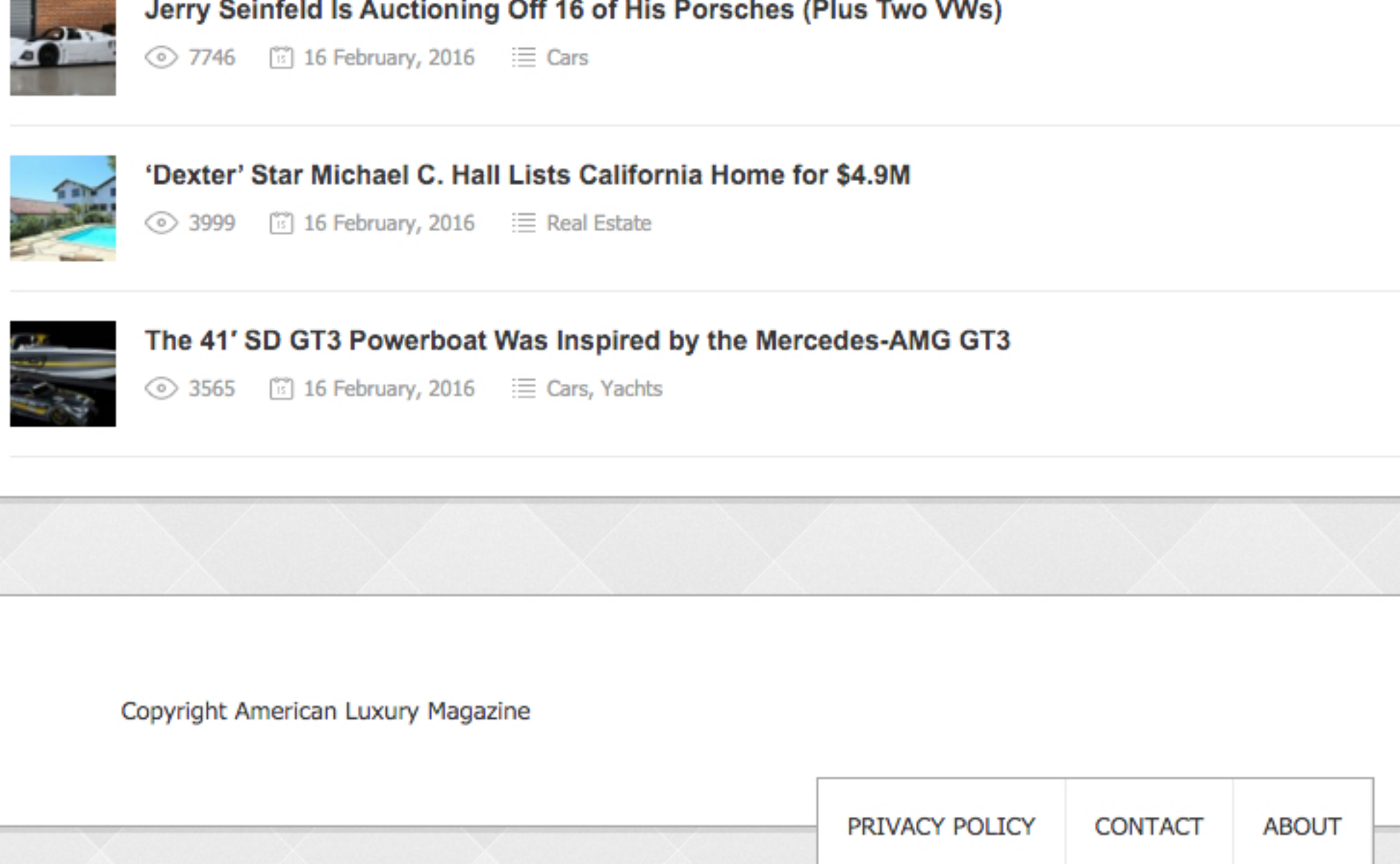
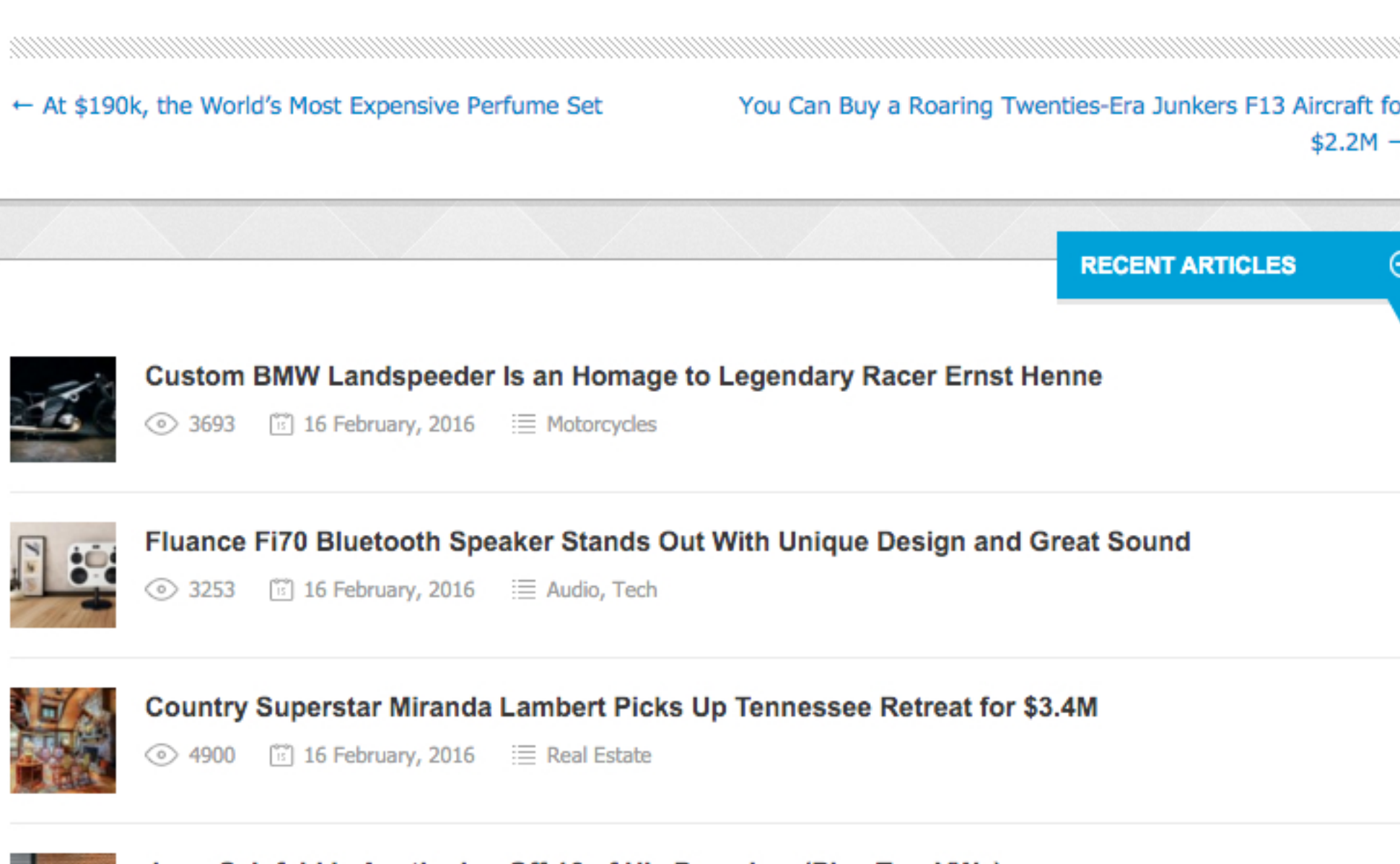
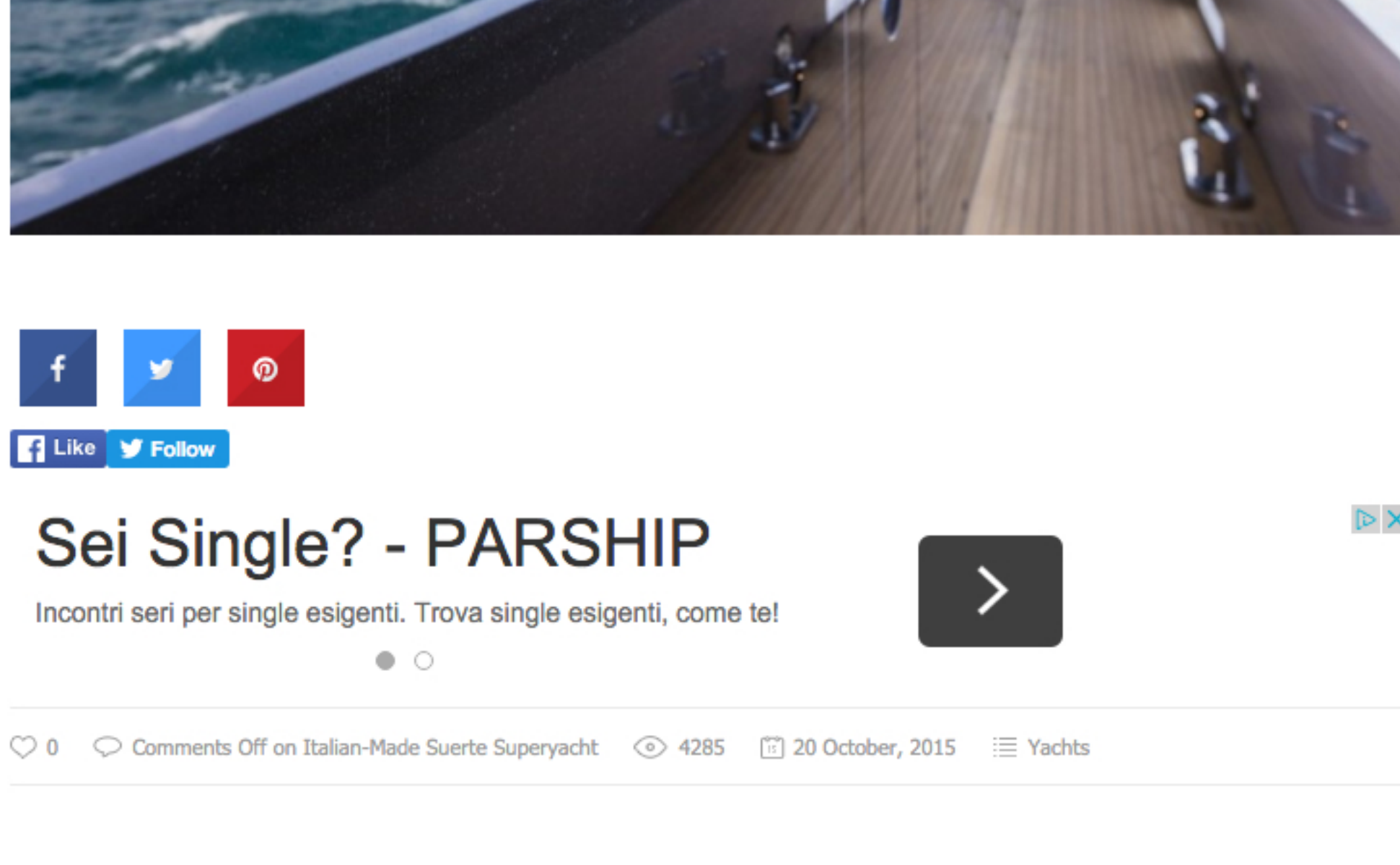
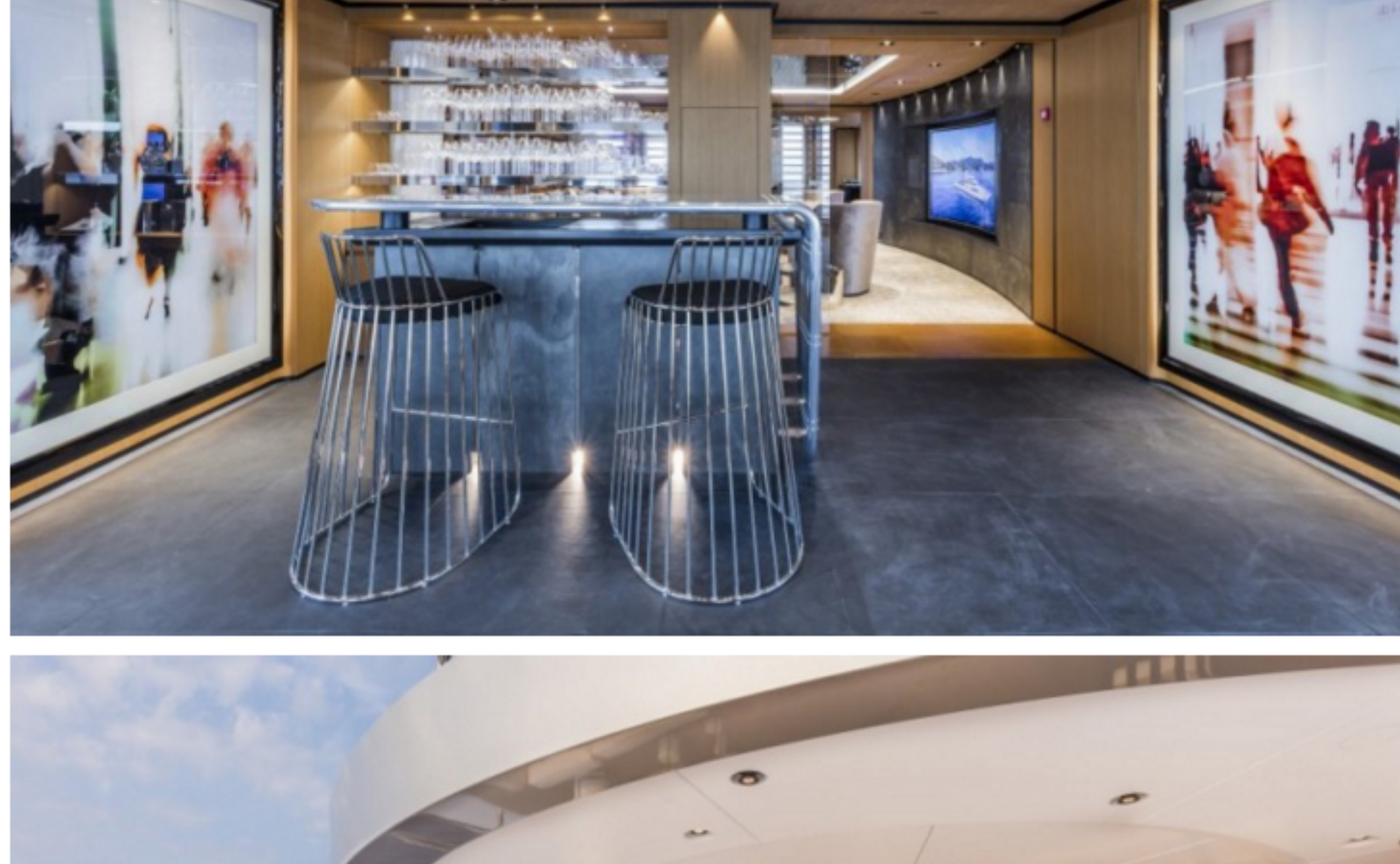
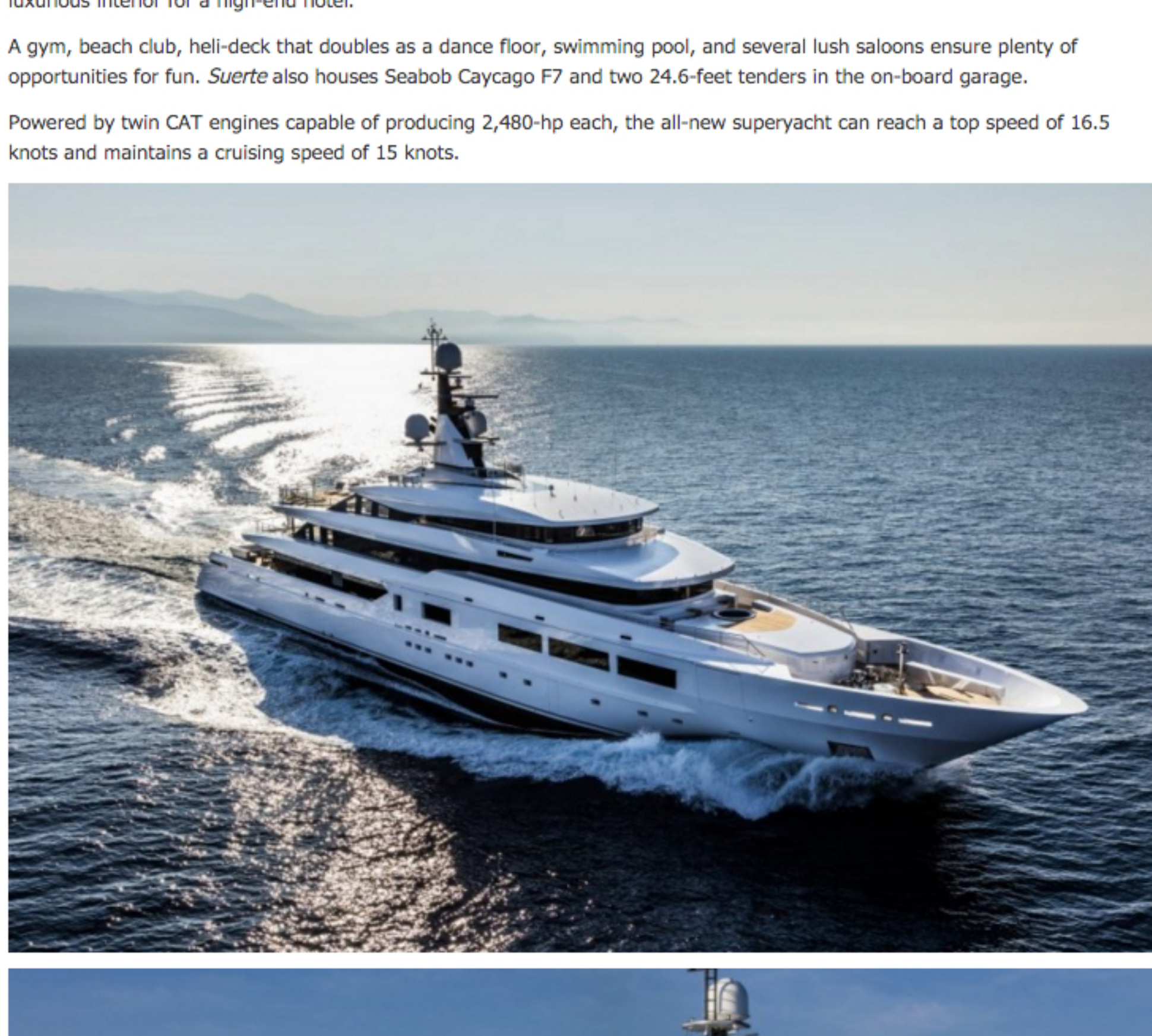
Tankoa's inaugural yacht stuns with a simple but structured exterior and plenty of space to relax and socialize. Designed by Francesco Paszkowski, the exterior and interior styles seamlessly blend to provide a chic and luxurious look.

The master suite is oval shaped and sports 180-degree views, a large sofa, and a private Jacuzzi with sun pads. Guests will also be comfortable in Suerte's VIP suite and four additional cabins.

Decorated with washed teak, black marble, lacquered details, and rich leather upholstery, visitors might mistake the yacht's luxurious interior for a high-end hotel.

A gym, beach club, heli-deck that doubles as a dance floor, swimming pool, and several lush saloons ensure plenty of opportunities for fun. Suerte also houses Seaboo Caycago F7 and two 24.6-foot tenders in the on-board garage.

Powered by twin CAT engines capable of producing 2,480-hp each, the all-new superyacht can reach a top speed of 16.5 knots and maintains a cruising speed of 15 knots.
