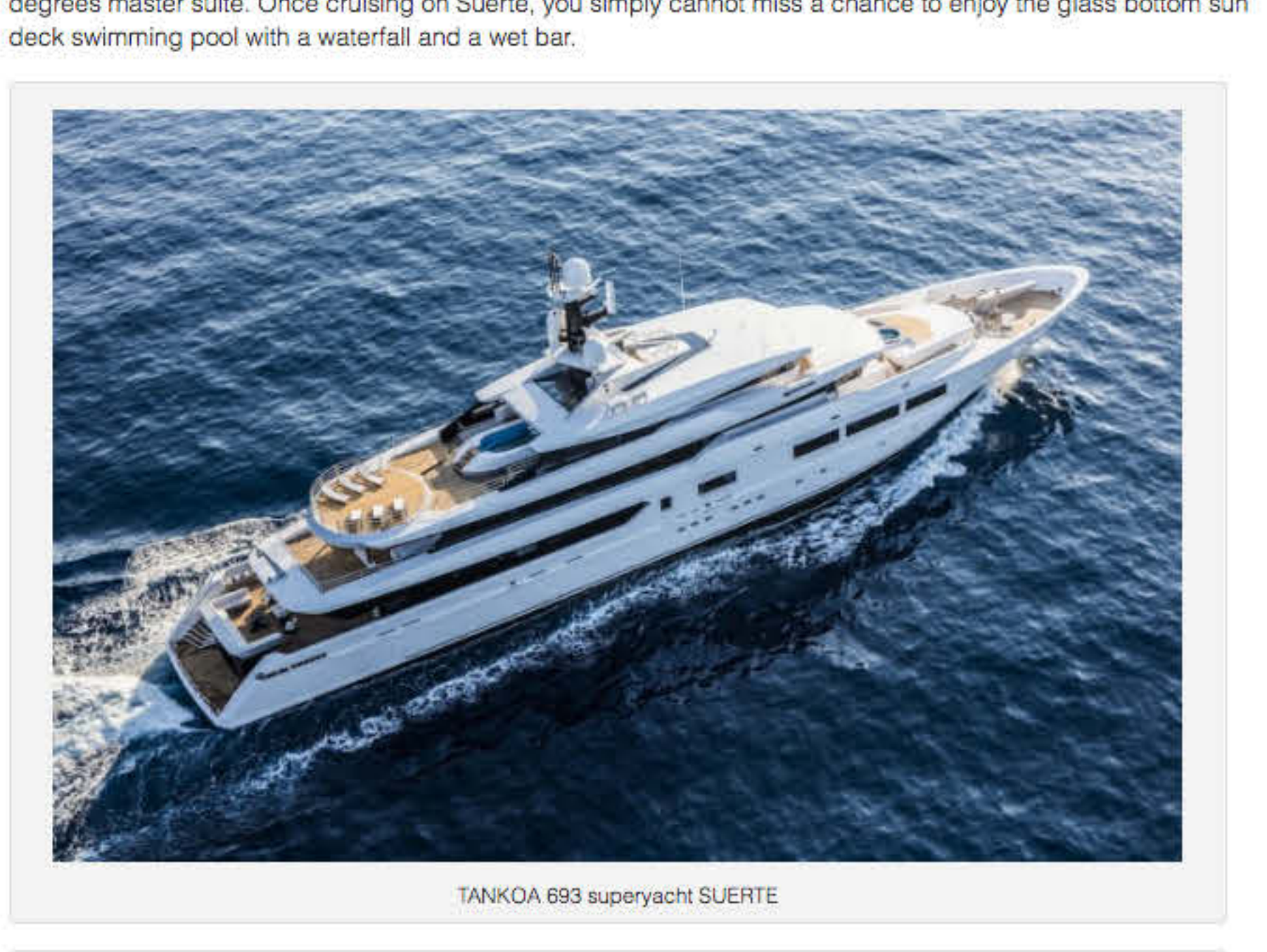

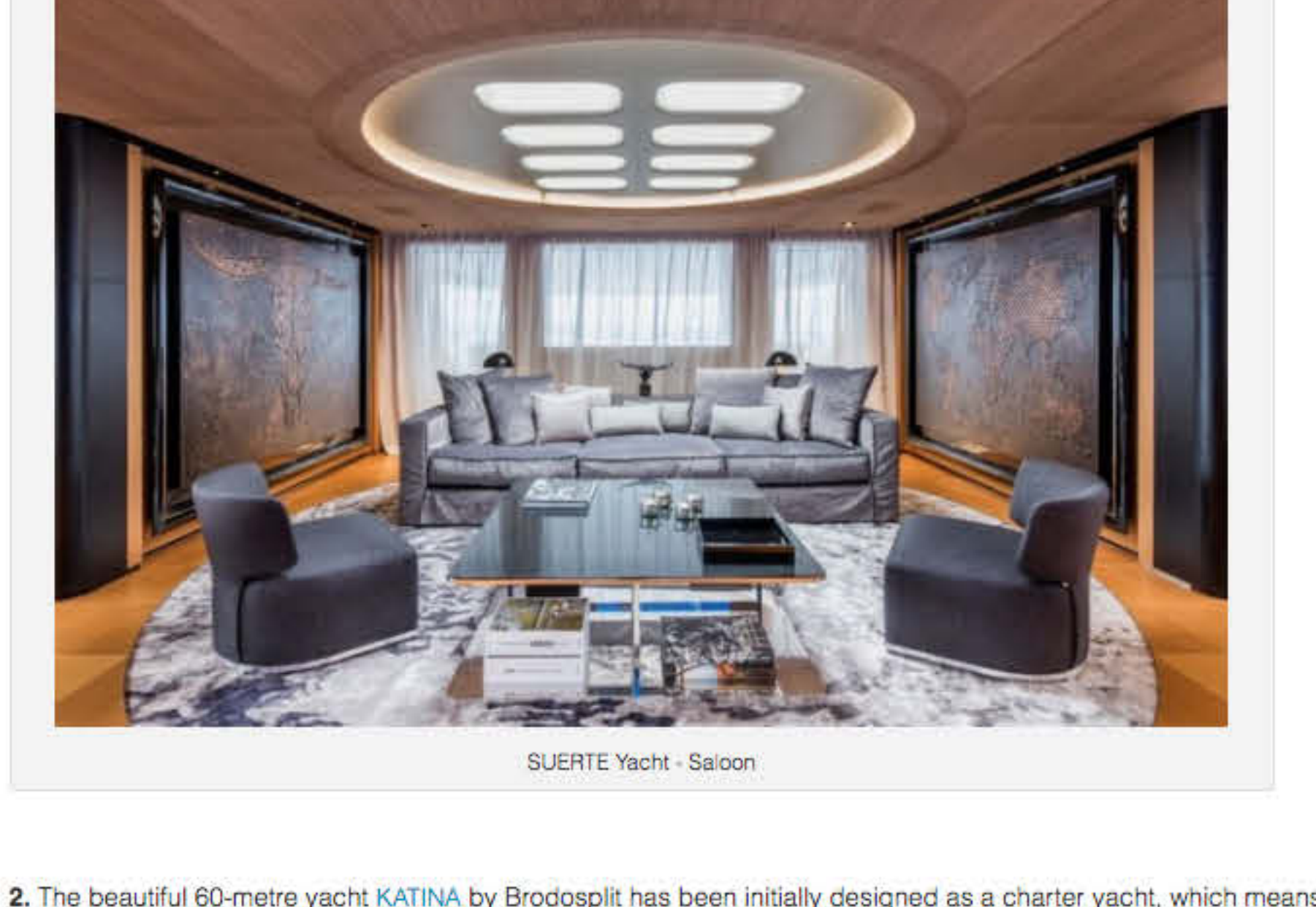

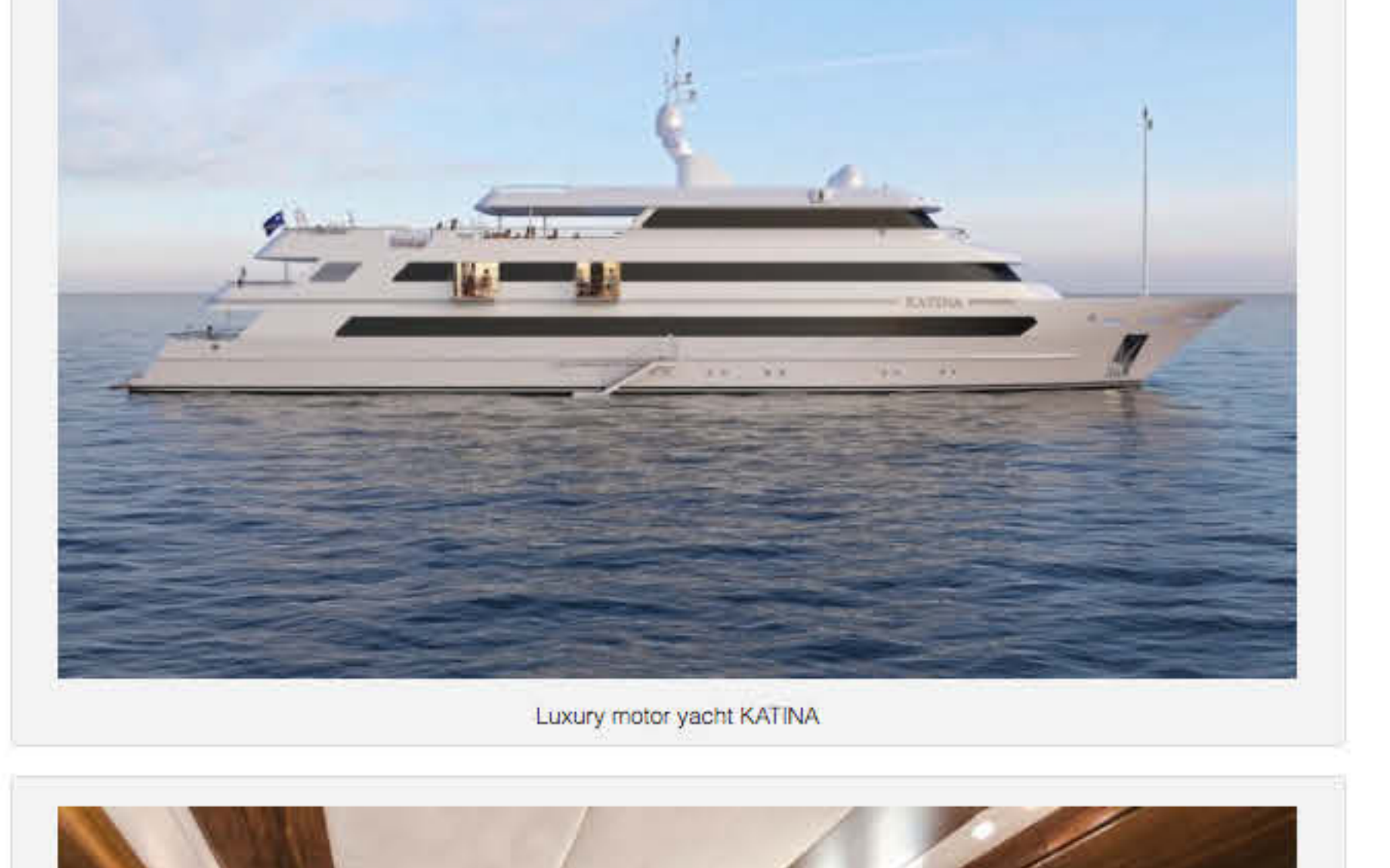


TANKOA 693 superyacht SUERTE

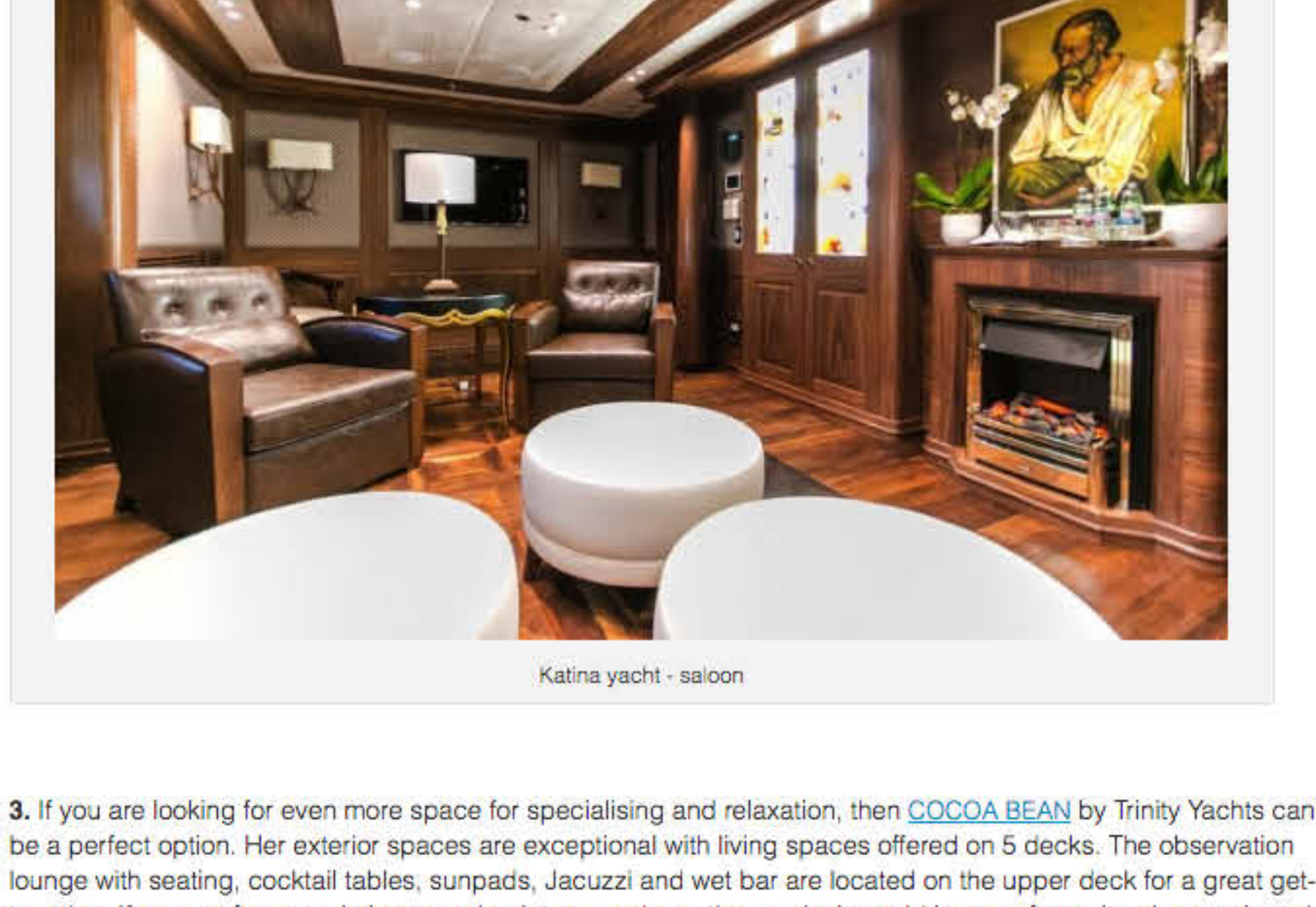


SUERTE Yacht - Saloon

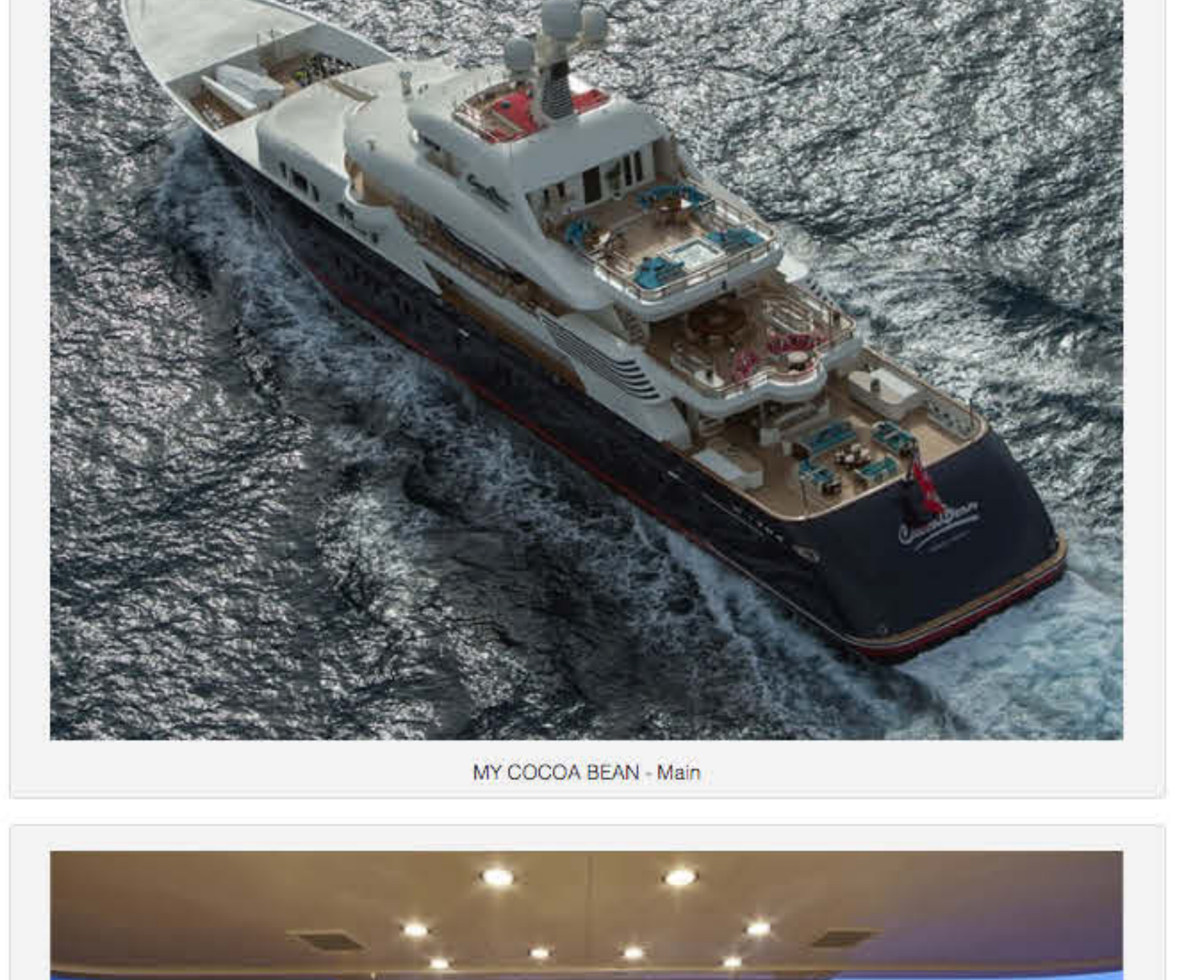


Luxury motor yacht KATINA

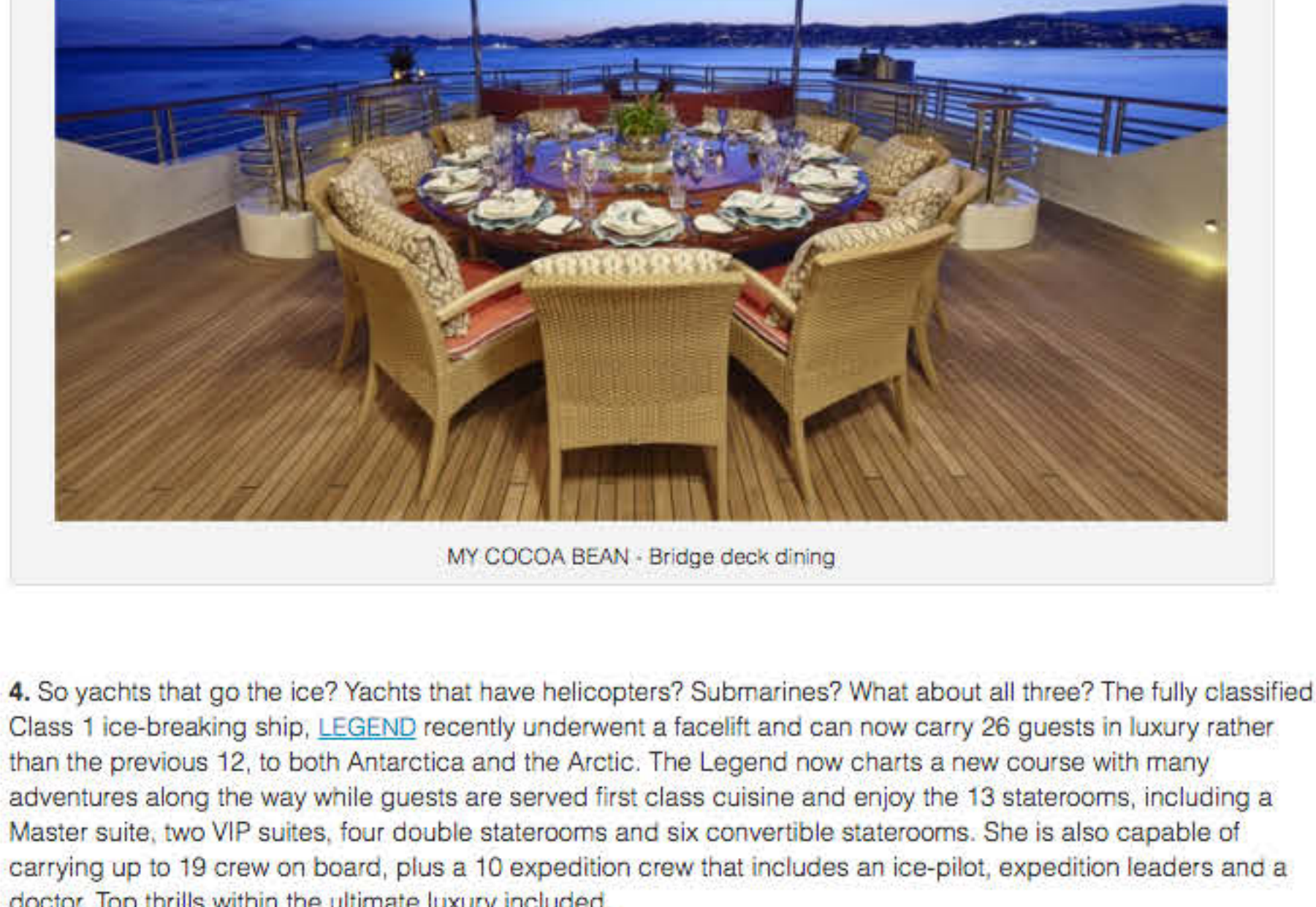


Katina yacht - saloon

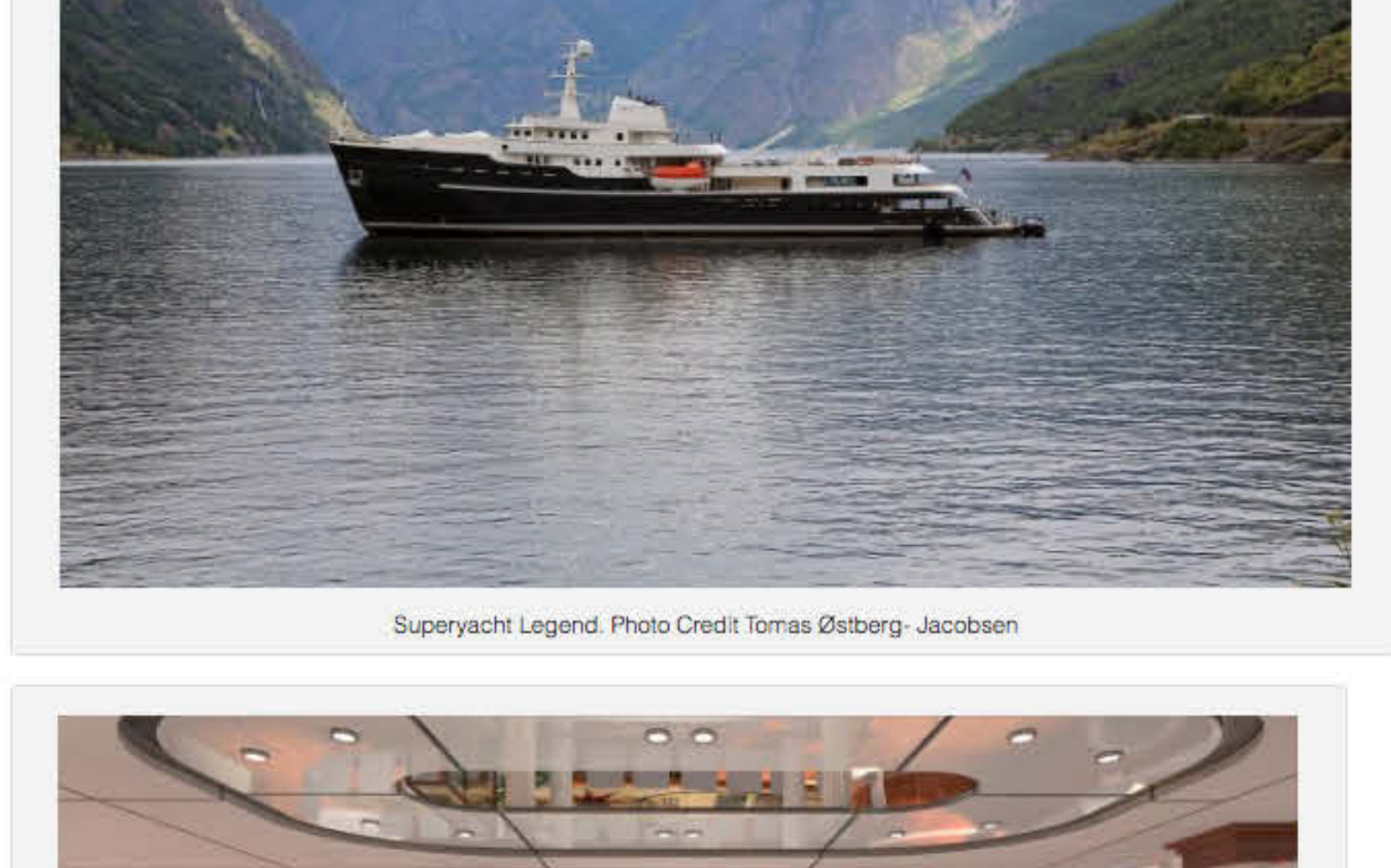


MY COCOA BEAN - Main

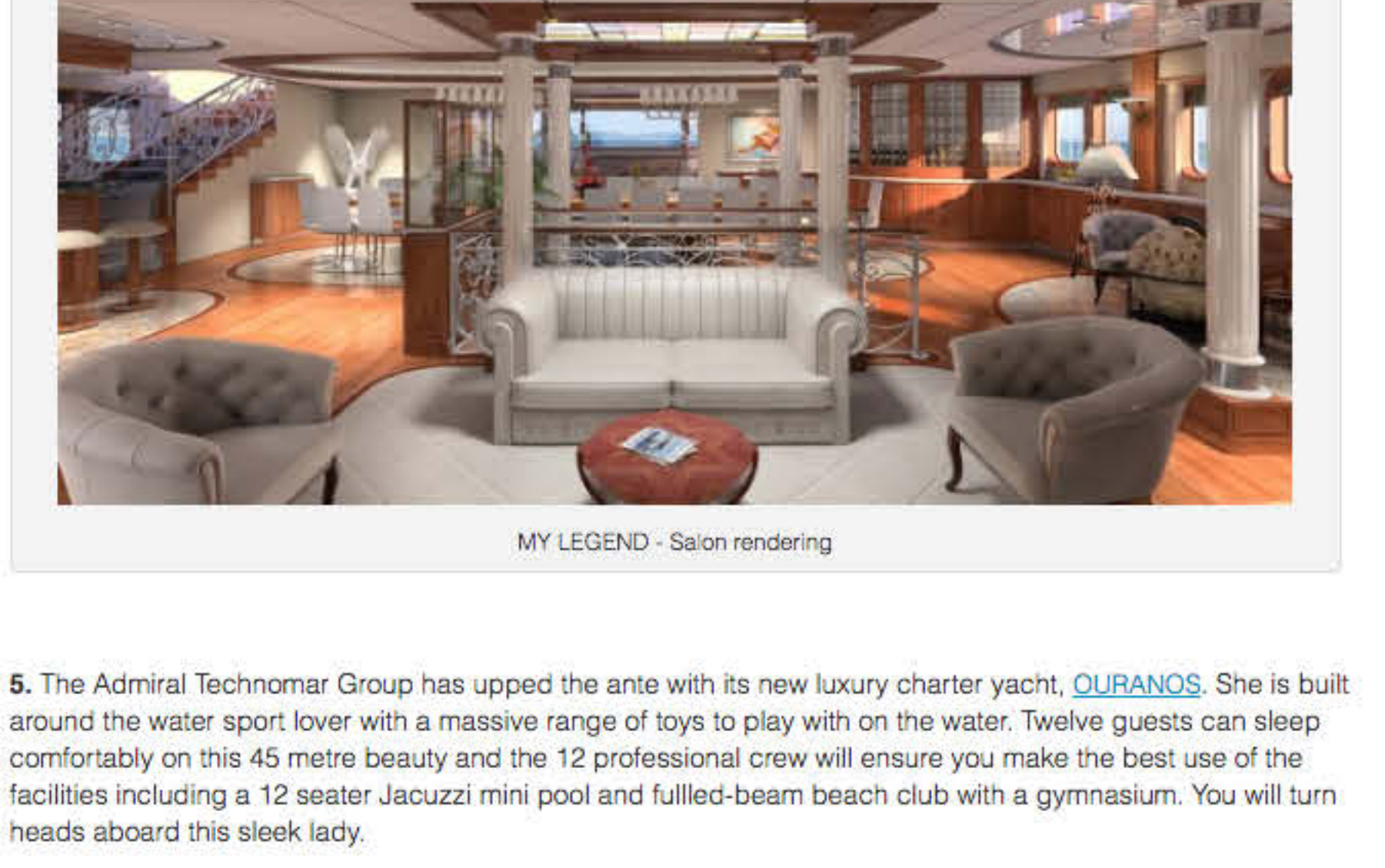


MY COCOA BEAN - Bridge deck dining

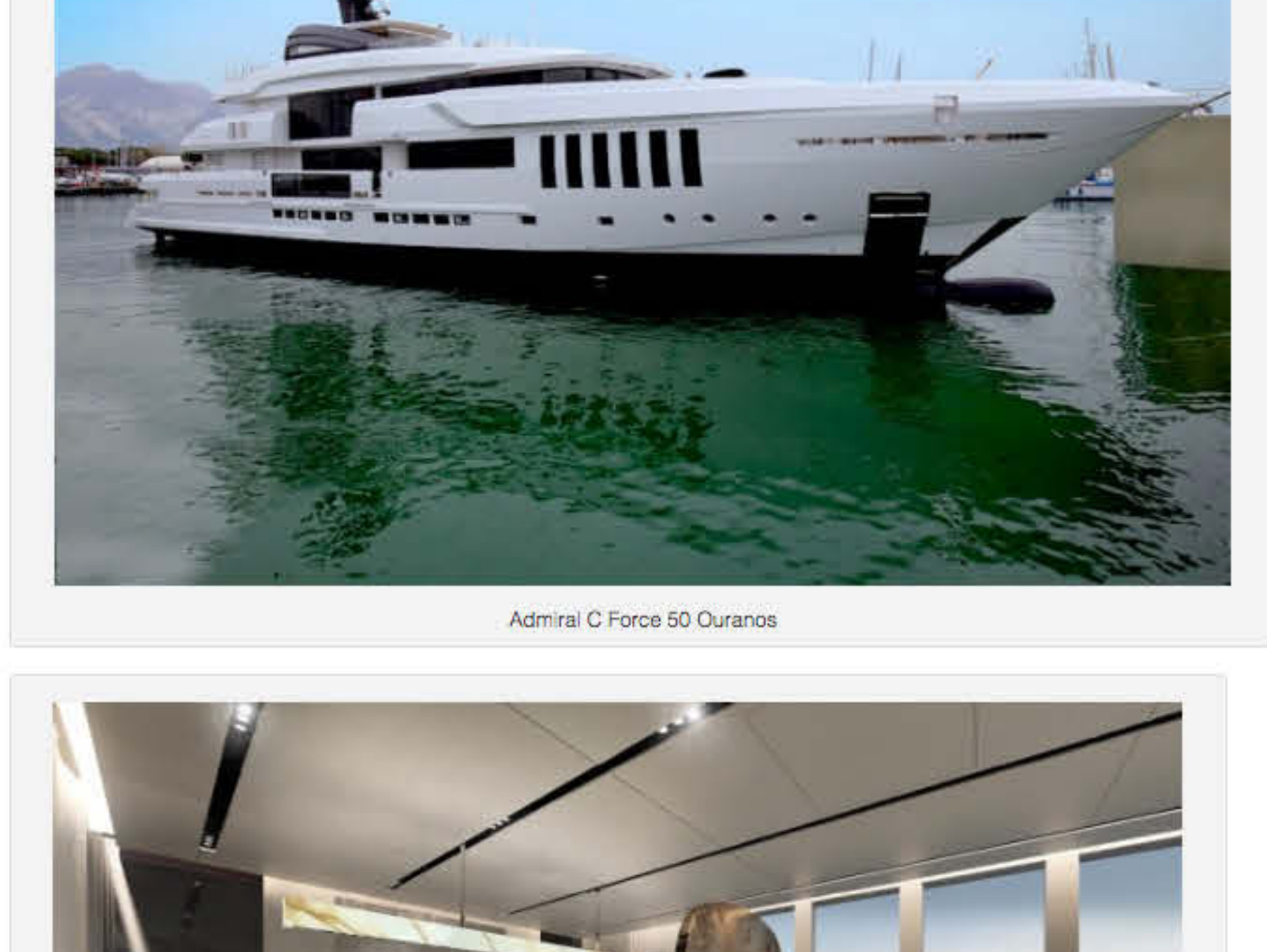

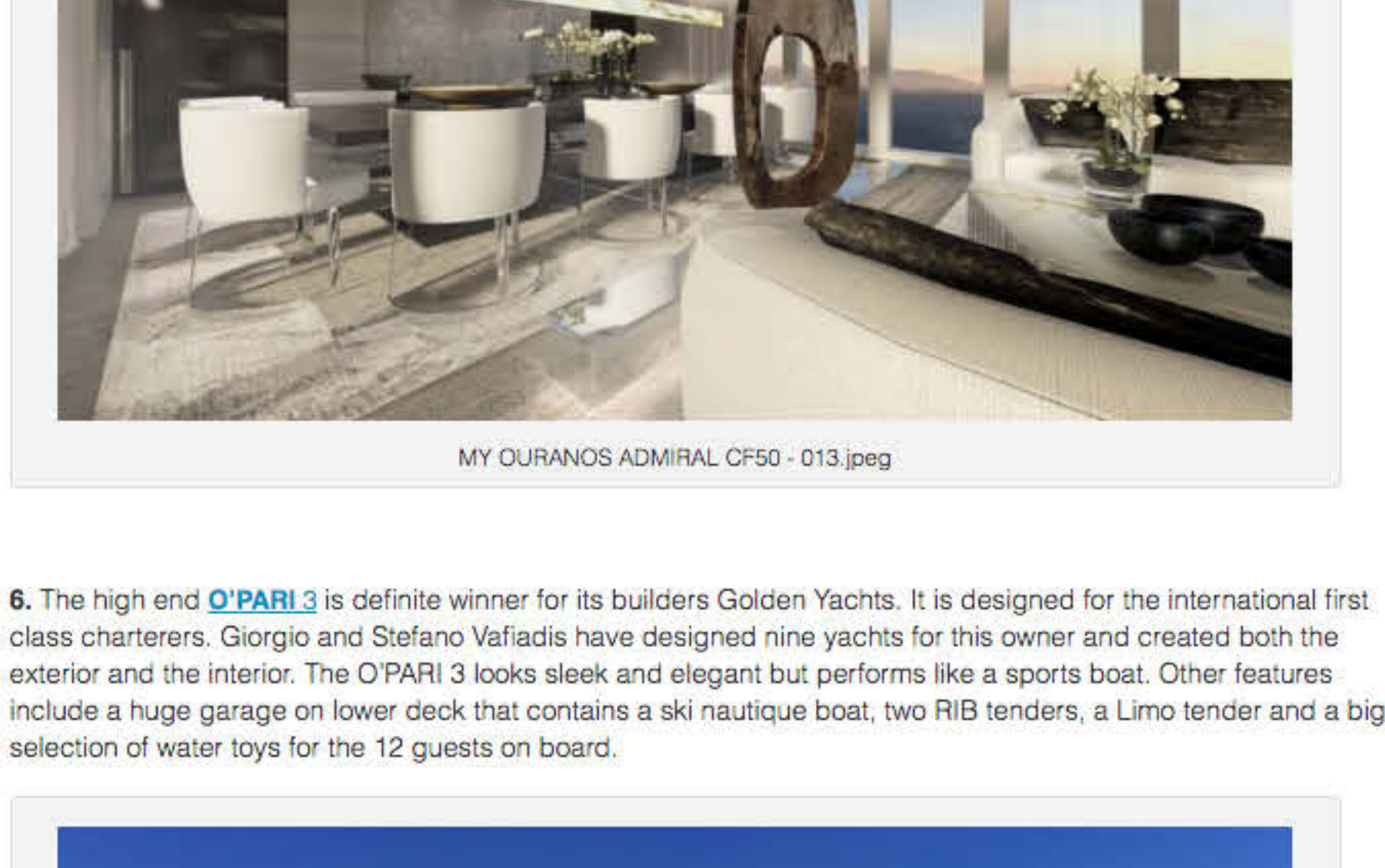


MY LEGEND - Saloon rendering

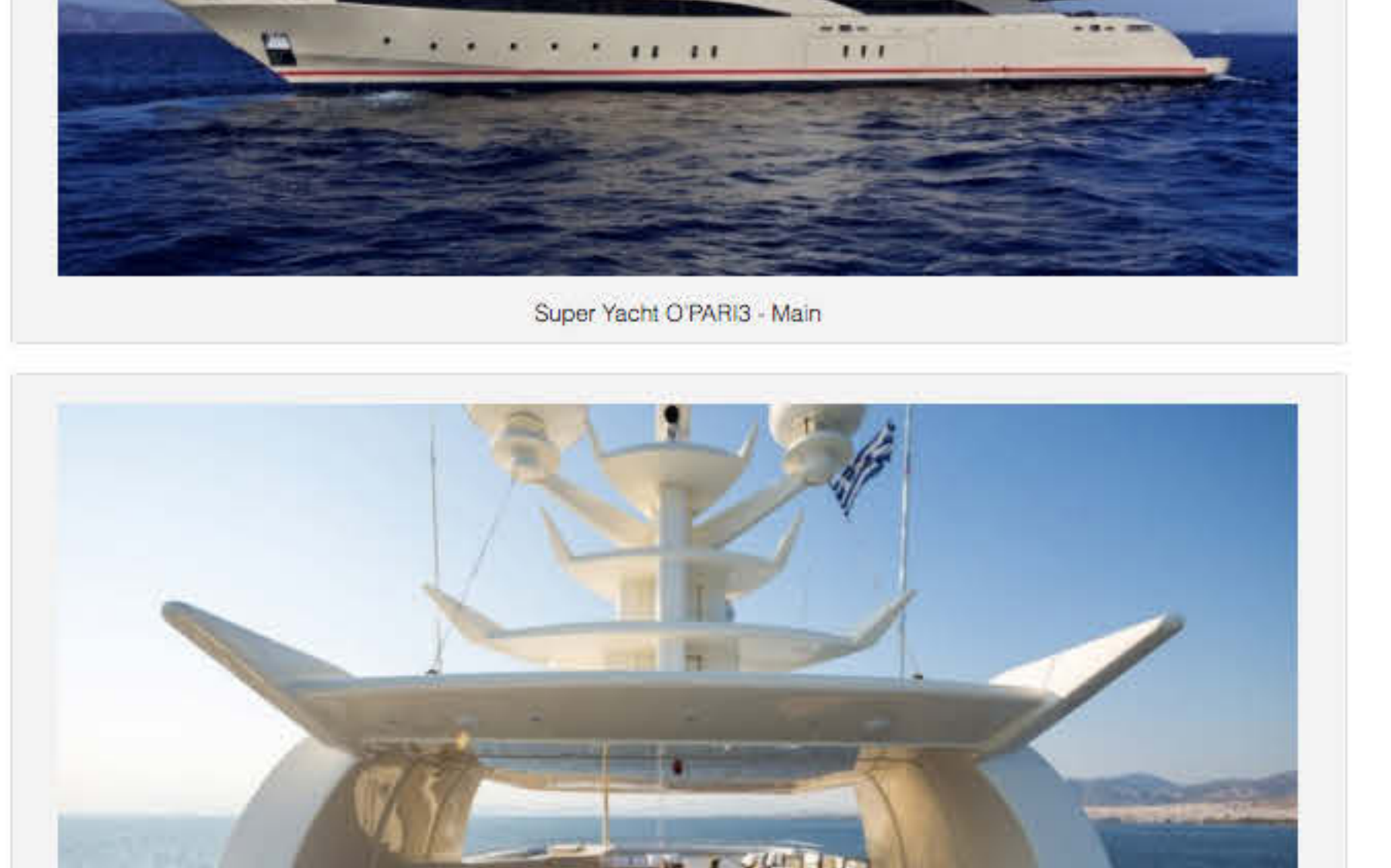


Admiral C Force 50 Ouranos

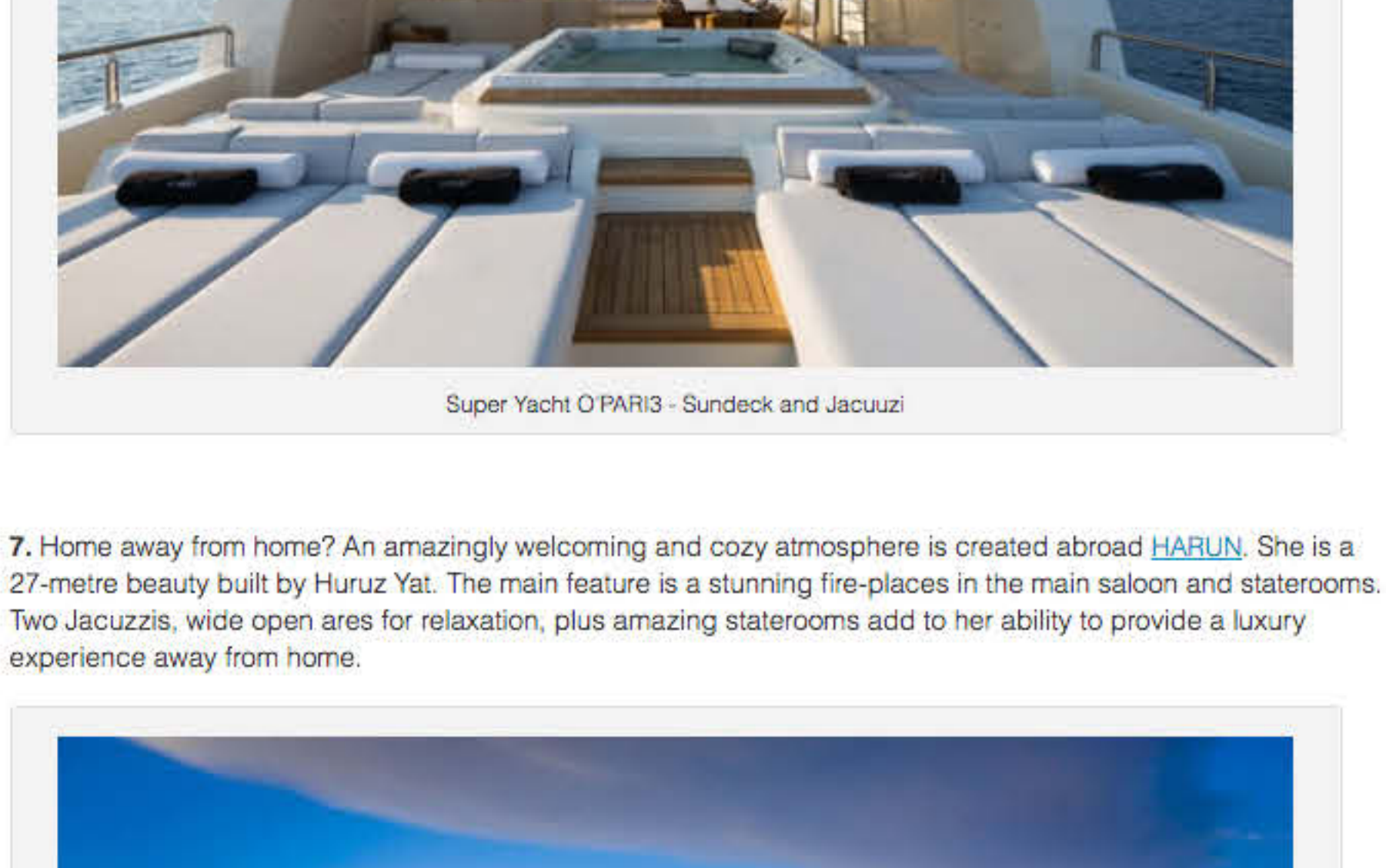

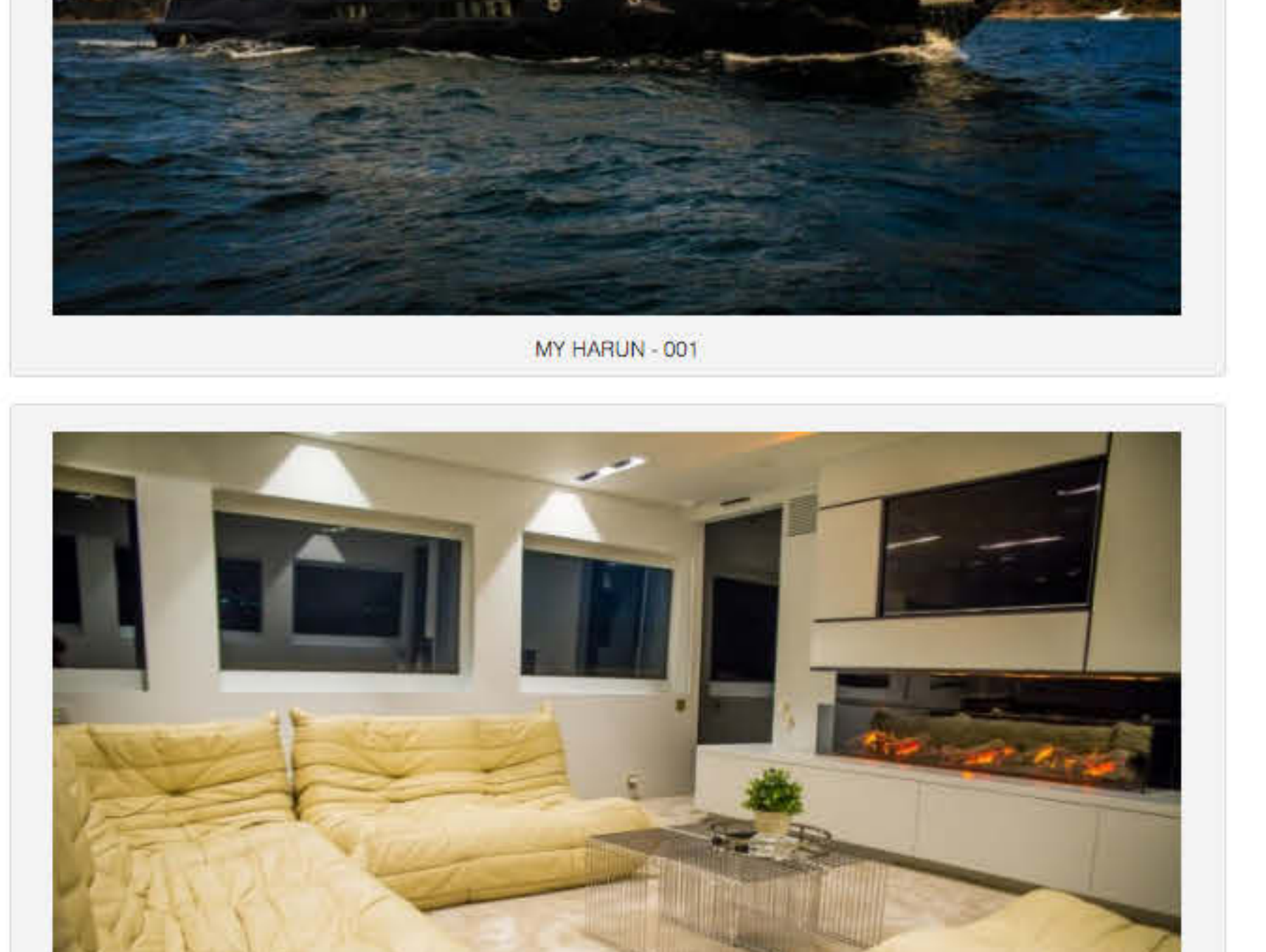


Super Yacht O'PARIS - Main

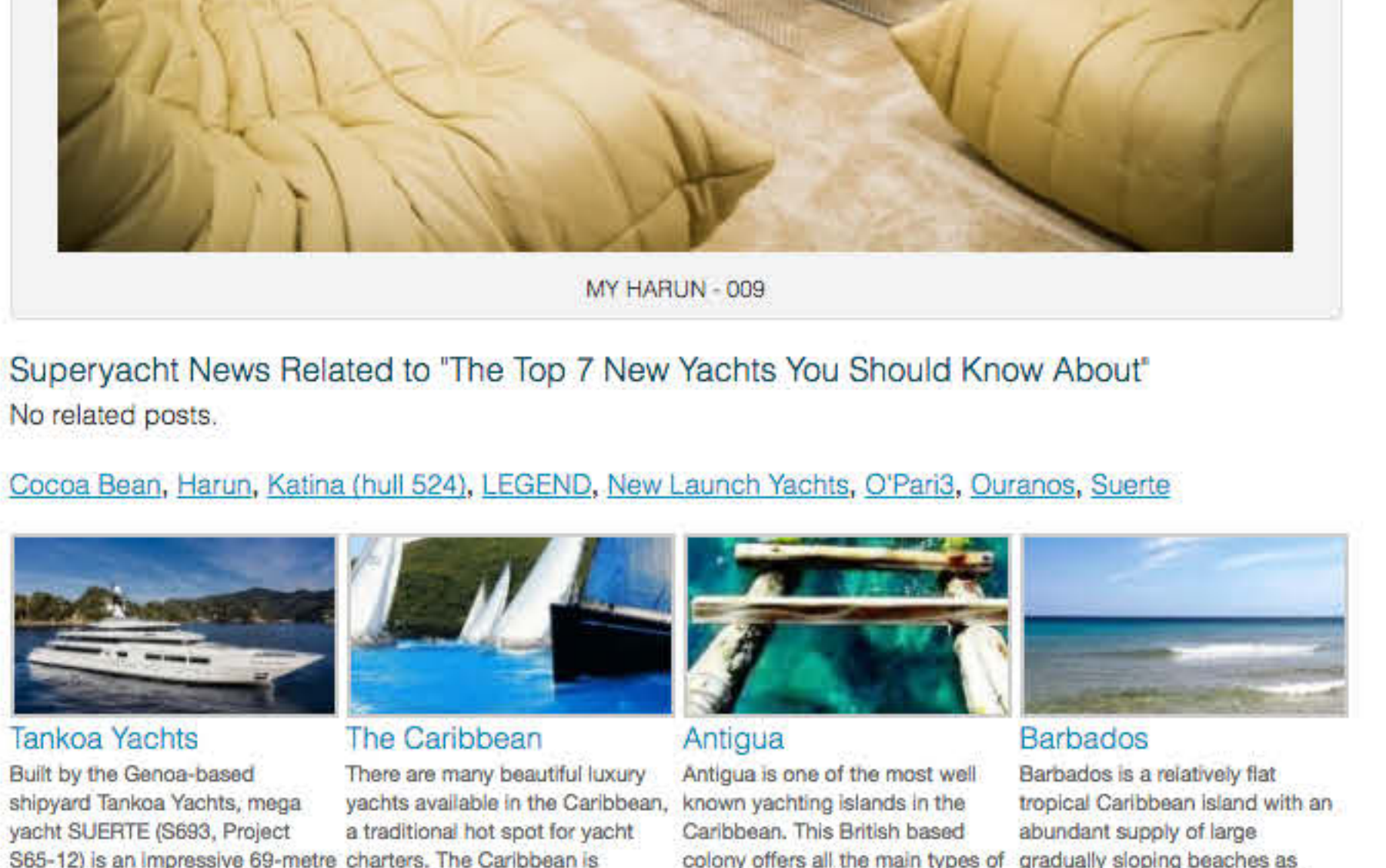


Super Yacht O'PARIS - Sundeck and Jacuzzi
